Phosphogypsum is a byproduct of fertilizer production. On August 25, 2021, the Manatee Circuit Court entered an order appointing Herbert R. Donica as a Receiver to take control of the Stack System and oversee its final closure. The purpose of the Receivership is to remove the pond water inventory, maintain, repair, and permanently close the Stack System so that it is no longer a threat to public safety and the environment. This procurement is for the closure of one of the four former phosphogypsum stack compartments, the Old Gyp Stack - South (the "OGS-S"). The OGS-S has an area of approximately 24 acres and does not currently hold standing water, except any accumulated rainfall. The OGS-S compartment was partially closed (i.e., lined with HDPE liner) and used to store marine sediments generated by the
