Specifically, the Project includes a Capital Improvement Plan to provide public infrastructure benefitting all lands within the District, as identified in the Engineer's Report. The Debt Assessments are proposed to be levied as one or more assessment liens and allocated to the benefitted lands within the District, as set forth in the Master Special Assessment Methodology Report ("Assessment Report"). At the conclusion of the public hearings, the Board will, by resolution, levy and impose assessments as finally approved by the Board. A special meeting of the District will also be held where the Board may consider any other business that may properly come before it. The site consists of approximately 182 acres, and is generally located south of Old New

York Avenue, west of Hontoon Road, and north and east of the St. Johns River. It is anticipated that the District will undertake a boundary amendment to add approximately 80 acres just to the east of the site. A geographic depiction of the District is shown below All lands within the District are expected to be improved in accordance with the reports identified above.
